Introduction

This scholarship is designed to assist those individuals.

Scholarship Benefits

Based on their unique situation, successful applicants may receive one or more of the following:

Eligibility Criteria

You may qualify for the EnterMedSchool Financial Hardship Scholarship if you meet **at least one** of the following conditions:

- (i) You reside in a region experiencing war or frequent violence, posing a threat to your personal safety.
- (ii) You are a victim of domestic or parental abuse, endangering your wellbeing.

(iii) You are a primary caregiver for ill or disabled family members or dependents, preventing you from maintaining a regular job.

- (iv) You have a significant personal illness or disability hindering your ability to work or attend classes.
- (v) You have little to no disposable income after covering essential living costs (e.g., rent, utilities, food), your household income is below your country's median, and your family assets are under one year's annual income.

Note: If you are physically able to work part-time but simply choose not to, you are not eligible for a **full scholarship**, though you may qualify for a partial discount. Please email Ari directly to learn more.

Scholarship Scoring System

We use a multi-factor system to evaluate each applicant's eligibility and level of need. Certain circumstances (such as exposure to war or abuse) automatically qualify you for scholarship consideration due to their severity. Otherwise, your total score is calculated based on the following criteria:

1. Living Situation (weight: 4)

- War-torn or significantly violent region: Immediate consideration
- Domestic or parental abuse: Immediate consideration
- Serious crisis (e.g., natural disaster): **Immediate consideration**
- No special circumstance: score 0

2. Caregiving Responsibilities (weight: 3)

- Extensive caregiving duties (ill or disabled dependents): Immediate consideration
- Moderate caregiving: score 1
- No caregiving responsibilities: score 0

3. Personal Illness or Disability (weight: 3)

- Significant illness or disability: **Immediate consideration**
- Moderate illness or disability: Immediate consideration
- No illness or disability: score 0

4. Financial Situation (weight: 4)

• No disposable income, below median income, and low assets: score 4

- Some disposable income or slightly above median: not eligible for this scholarship tier
- No financial hardship: not eligible

5. Academic Performance (weight: 2)

- Outstanding (consistently high grades): score 2
- Average: score 1
- Below average: score 0

6. Personal Motivation & Goals (unweighted)

- Strong dedication and clearly defined objectives: score 0.5
- Moderate motivation, partially formed goals: score 0.2
- No clear motivation or goals: not eligible

7. Previous IMAT 2024 Exam Performance (unweighted)

- Score above 60: score 1
- Score above 40: score 0.5
- Score under 30: score 0

8. Engagement with Free Materials (weight: 2, optional)

- Completed free materials and actively contributed to the community: score 1
- Completed some free materials: score 0.5

Total Score is calculated (for applicants not already qualifying under *Immediate consideration*) as:

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Total Score = (Living Situation Score \times 4)
+ (Caregiving Responsibilities Score \times 3)
+ (Illness/Disability Score \times 3)
+ (Financial Situation Score \times 4)
+ (Academic Performance Score \times 2)
+ (Personal Motivation Score \times 2)
+ (IMAT Exam Performance Score \times 2)
+ (Engagement Score \times 2).
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Note: If you meet any criterion listed as "Immediate consideration," your application will automatically be given priority review.

Email Requirements

- **Introduction:** Provide a detailed description of your financial situation and the reasons you require assistance.
- Impact: Explain the short, mid, and long-term implications of your financial circumstances, including any relevant figures if possible.
- **Supporting Documents:** Attach all relevant evidence, such as:
 - Recent payslips, tax summaries, or proof of government benefits.
 - Medical records or doctor's letters if illness or disability is relevant.
 - Proof of living conditions (e.g., rent contracts, utility bills).
- **Claimed Factors:** Address *every factor* (from the Scoring System) that applies or does not apply to you. Provide documents where possible.
- Why EnterMedSchool?: Share your motivation for enrolling in our program and how financial support will help you achieve your IMAT and educational goals.

Mandatory Attachments

If you are missing some documents, please provide the reasoning in the email.

- DoV (Declaration of Value or relevant local equivalent).
- Passport and official ID.
- **Proof of pre-enrollment** (if available; if the admissions cycle has not started yet, please note that).
- **Proof of salaries and yearly income** of caretakers or supporting family members for the past two years.
- Proof of address and housing size (copies of bills with official names).

• **Proof of current studies** (if you are in high school, a university course, or a foundation year). Attach a slip proving you pay tuition fees. If your institution provides you with scholarships, attach it as well.

• Additional Documentation (if relevant): Medical records for you or your family, or any other evidence supporting the claims in your email.

Important: An *income tax summary* from your government's tax department is generally the safest and clearest proof of your current financial status.
